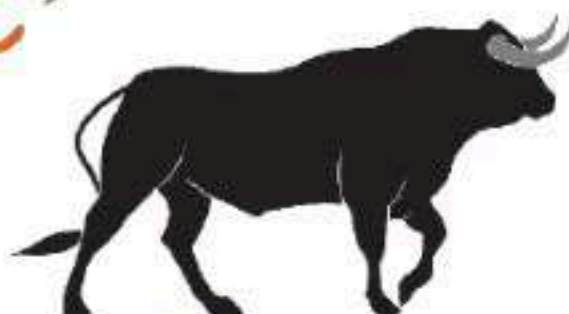

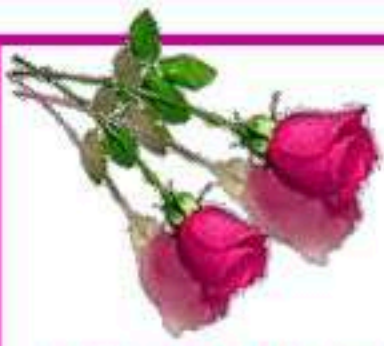

The Microwave Oven

The microwave oven is a common appliance that is used in kitchens all around the world today. Many people are so used to using a microwave that they have forgotten about all of the advantages the microwave has given to cooks. 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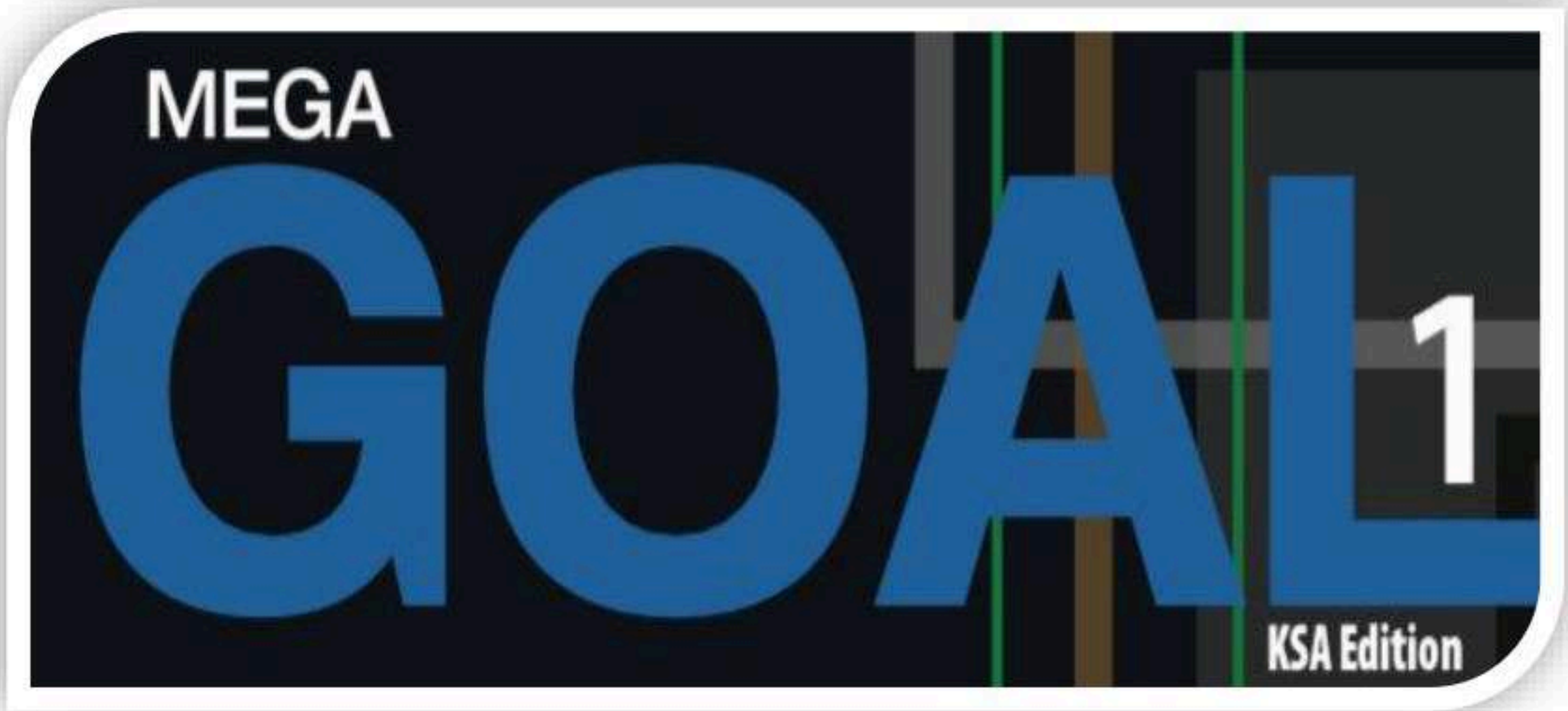
